Is there a Ski & Snowboard Rental on site. [The Ski and Snowboard shop in our hotel is managed by Whistler Blackcomb \(Vail Resorts\) and they are looking into sending us rental forms to complete before our arrival to save time, plus group rental rates. Their hours of operation may vary but currently are open from 7am-6pm.](#)

Do you have Ski & Snowboard storage: [Our group will be able to store skis complimentary at the rental shop, in our hotel, or at their location at the Carlton lodge. They do allow guests to bring boots to their rooms so they will dry overnight.](#)

How long of a walk to lifts and or gondola? [5-minutes, little longer when walking in ski boots](#)

Please explain where to catch shuttle and times? [Our complimentary shuttle runs from 8am-4pm daily, and a sign to line up for the shuttle is right out the front entrance of our hotel. Our shuttle is a Mercedes spring van and holds 11 people and skis and does loops back and forth between the lifts \(takes about 3mins\).](#)

Can we sign up with other activities through your hotel? How far is the Olympic Venues? Do you have shuttle service or can we catch a bus to visit these amazing history sites? [Please have a look at the following website for <https://www.whistlersportlegacies.com> as this will provide you with where some of the Olympic venues are located. The celebration plaza were the medal ceremonies where in 2010 are located about 50 meters from our hotel and the Olympic rings are there, it's so great spot for a group picture. There is an outdoor skating rink there as well. You would need to take a taxi up to the sliding center which is about 10 minutes from the village. However, the cross country and Ski jumping Olympic sites are in the Callahan valley which is a 45-minute drive from Whistler. We can certainly help with booking activities for your group and once you are ready to arrange activities, I will send over the contact information.](#)
